

Margherita Emma Turvani, Full Professorship, National Habilitation in Political Economy and Economic Policy and Associate Professor of Political Economy and Economic Policy in the University IUAV of Venice and in Venice International University, has an outstanding record of study and research in the field of Sustainable Development and Economics, Regional and Urban Economics, developed out of her previous studies and research on Economics of Innovation and Creativity and extensive work and research in New Institutional Economics. Having a strong background in social sciences, microeconomics and econometrics, since her education in Economics and Political Sciences, she has a record in multidisciplinary investigation and collaboration in teaching which academicians and experts in various other fields, like environmental science, information technologies, and architects and planner as well. The complexity and richness of her research experience is also manifested in her teaching activities through time, which span from economics for urban and regional sustainable development, public and ecological economics, to economics for science and innovation and the knowledge society.

Her major recent contributions are in the field of environmental economics and valuation of non-market goods, which are also paired with contribution in the field of urban and regional policies for regeneration and growth, in major international economic journals. She has contributed with publication in high rank journals also in the field of land use planning and participatory governance models. Previously, she has an excellent record of publication in the field of Institutional Economics and Economics of Innovation. She introduced the original work of Nobel Laureate Oliver E. Williamson to the Italian Academy in 1985, translating from English two of his books.

She has been visiting scholar in major excellent universities in the USA, like Stanford, MIT, Columbia, and she has a record of intensive relations with Chinese Institutions, such as CASS and Most, and several Chinese Municipalities, like Shanghai and Beijing, being cooperating for 12 years, since 2003, with Venice International University, which is technical partner of the Italian Ministry for the Environment, Land and Sea for the Sino-Italian Advanced Training Program on Environmental Management and Sustainable Development. Within this Program she has been also responsible as Students Advisor, for the Tongji University & Venice International University Cooperation and Exchange Program with Unep Tongji, and for the Tsinghua University, School of environment & Venice International University Cooperation and Exchange Program. In the period 2004-2013 she has regularly visited China at least twice a year for teaching activities within the IMELS Sino-Italian Advanced Training Program on Environmental Management and Sustainable Development Programme for China.

She has been Chief Investigator in several National and EU funded research grants and she has covered many institutional duties on behalf of her Italian University (IUAV of Venice) where now she is pro-chancellor for international affairs with China and responsible for International activities with CAUP Tongji, Shanghai and HIT Graduate school in Shenzhen. She seats in the Board of Directors of Venice International University (www.viu.org) on behalf of IUAV University, founder partner of VIU.
