In 2011 Belarus and Ukraine have been involved for the first time in the Course for Sustainability.

## Course for Sustainability for Ukraine and Belarus

The Course is developed and organized in collaboration with the REC and Agroinnova. Participants are selected among high representatives of Ukrainian and Belarusian governments as well as from the business and academic sector of the targeted regions. The agenda faces crucial environmental issues for the region such as: policy and tools to promote sustainability, environmental economics and green economy, urban development, agriculture, waste management, water pollution and radioactivity environmental concerns.
